

## General Requirements for Testing and Agency Submittal

- Provide four working units with appropriate cards and software, and auxiliary equipment including power supplies, power cords, etc.
- Ensure units are properly configured; pre-test prior to sending to RTL.
- Include product set-up and configuration procedure.

## General Documentation Requirements for U.S. Approval

- Technical Operational Description
- Schematics
- Electrical Block Diagram
- Parts List
- Sample Product Label, with appropriate marks and identifiers, and placement
- User Manual with required regulatory and safety statements
- Professional Installation Manual, if required
- Antenna Specifications, if applicable
- Internal and External Product Photographs
- Attestation Letters as required
- Agency Authorization Letter
- Confidentiality Request Letter, if required

The applicable agency filing fees must be received by RTL before client applications can be submitted to the regulatory bodies.

Applications for approval outside the U.S. may require additional documentation, including the following:

- PCB Layouts
- Sales Brochure
- Test Reports and Certificates Issued by Other Labs
- Manufacturer's Company Profile
- Manufacturer's Business License Copy
- Manufacturer's ISO 9000 Certificate Copy
- Manufacturer's Distributorship Appointment Letter

*Note: These lists may not be inclusive; the documentation requirements vary, based on the application type and reviewing body. Some documents may require translation. First-time clients will need to provide other information. RTL can provide samples of required documents and labels.*
